Qualifications in audit report on historical financial information: There are no qualifications in the audit report of the Guarantor on its audited historical financial information.

Key risks in respect of the Guarantor: The Guarantor is subject to the following key risks:

• The Guarantor is exposed to concentrations of risk, particularly credit and market risk. As regulatory or market developments continue to lead to increased centralisation of trading activities, the Guarantor could experience an increase in concentration of risk, which could limit the effectiveness of any hedging strategies and cause the Guarantor to incur significant losses.
