#### 2. What are the risks and what could I get in return?

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until 15 March 2028. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less. You may not be able to sell your product easily or may have to sell at a price that significantly impacts on how much you get back.



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 6 out of 7, which is the second-highest risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a high level, and poor market conditions are very unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

To the extent the currency of the country in which you purchase this product or your account currency differs from the product currency, please be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

This product does not include any protection from future market performance so you could lose some or all of your investment.

The favourable, moderate and unfavourable scenarios represent possible outcomes that have been calculated based on simulations using the reference asset's performance over up to 5 past years. ## 4. What are the costs?

### 5. How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

#### **Recommended holding period: 5 years**

The product aims to provide you with the return described under "1. What is this product?" above. However, this only applies if the product is held to maturity. It is therefore recommended that the product is held until 15 March 2028 (maturity).

The product does not guarantee the possibility to disinvest other than by selling the product either (1) through the exchange (if the product is exchange traded) or (2) offexchange, where an offer for such product exists. No fees or penalties will be charged by the issuer for any such transaction, however an execution fee might be chargeable by your broker if applicable.
